Minutes of 2021 Annual General Meeting

IDENTIFICATION OF MEMBERS:

On conference call: Dan Hays, Kathy Hays, Terri Worms, Sean Tolton, Philip Thordarson, Gib Drury/Victor Drury, Allan Johnson, Cody Renz, Trudy Gorday, Sandra Marsh, Brenna and Russ Sazwan

ADOPTION TO ADOPT MINUTES:

Moved by Gib, seconded by Allan, approved.

PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS AND ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION:

Sean: 170-175 cows. Sold 122 calves in the fall. Dry summer but enough feed. Bred 2 mature Hays bulls with 70 cows. Lots of 50% animals. Will get his registrations up to date.

Philip. 108 females, 7 Hays bulls, kept 22 heifers. Making good progress with polled animals. In November, transferred 20 cows and 25 heifers to Sazwans. Transferred a bull to Cody and registered 22 heifers and 4 bulls.

Victor/Gib: 23 purebred cows not held in separate pasture this year and were bred to Angus bull within the larger herd of 200 cows. Used HC bull for cleanup. Lots of 50%. Kept 64 bred heifers. Last year's calves (200) are on feed and for sale in spring. Calving out 260 cows.

Allan: 25 mature cows with 25 calves (18 heifers/7 bull calves). Calved March 15-April 30. Good average weights (623 lbs heifers, 660 lbs steers)

Cody: Running 30 HCs (pure and ½ bloods). Sold calves early due to dry conditions with OK prices. Did not show animals this year due to Covid restrictions. Hopefully, next year....

Trudy: 260-270 bred to Hays bulls. Lots of percentage animals. 2 8 pure bred cows. Registered 6 heifers and 3 bulls. Bought 5 heifers and 2 Bulls from Philip. Hays bull will be turned out in spring.

Brenna Sazwan: 54 Cows including 21 registered HC and 6 or 7 yearling heifers. Has registered appropriate animals. Using a double-polled bull to achieve as many polled animals as possible. Daughters in 4H will show Hays Converters.

Dan and Kathy: Australia has over 100 HC on the ground with about 200 ETs in the tank. Has ordered another 100 ETs. U of A Kinsella Station sent 1 mature cow and 2 cow/calf pairs to Davis Rairdan to

accommodate this new order. Vern at Kinsella is keeping heifers as replacements trying to build up a younger herd. 10 bulls on GrowSafe with possibly 5 for sale next year.

SECRETARY MANAGER'S REPORT: Read and accepted. Moved by Cody, seconded by Sandra, approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Approval moved by Kathy, seconded by Gib, approved.

ELECTION OF DIRECTORS:

5 Renewals: Philip, Sandra, Allan, Kathy and Ivan. Suggested the removal of Ivan at this time, and added Brenna. Moved by Philip and seconded by Terri, approved.

NAMING REVIEWERS, SIGNING OFFICERS AND REP TO CLRC:

Motion to retain Reviewers (Dunphy Accounting Firm); Signing officers (Terri Worms and Dan Hays) and representative to the CLRC (Gib/Victor in East – Dan and Cody in West)

Moved by Gib, seconded by Sandra, carried.

NEW BUSINESS: President addressed the fact that he has held this position for some time. It was suggested that members complete a nomination form to be prepared by Terri indicating their selection for President, Vice-President and Secretary Manager. Forms to be returned by January 31, 2022 at which time results would be announced.

The issue of on-line registration was discussed and our bylaws still need to be legally amended. Gib moved a resolution that the Association approve on-line registrations. Seconded by Philip. Approved.
